Indenture dated 9 March 1899

William Hardy to George White of Quordon

Conveyance dated 1876

Joseph Sheppard to Samuel Lamb ('joiner and wheelwright')

Mortgage dated 7 April 1904

Samuel Lamb to George Frederick Grimbley ('grocers assistant in Loughborough') and William Cooper ('licensed victualler in Loughborough')

Mortgage dated 7 October 1915

Samuel Lamb to Miss Ada Cotton ('of Loughborough')

states that former occupants include John Chamberlain, then Elizabeth Sheppard then Samuel Lamb

Conveyance dated 2 May 1919

Sarah Ann Lamb (estate of Samuel Lamb) to Henry Lamb ('wheelwright')

Reconveyance dated 10 February 1920

to Ada Cotton of Stoneygate ('spinster')

Mortgage dated 23 August 1954

Henry Lamb to Midland Bank

Conveyance dated 16 November 1964

Mrs Doris Newton (widow of William Henry Newton) to Miss Rhoda Lamb and Miss
Mary Elizabeth Lamb
[the three women were all sisters]

Legal charge dated 16 November 1964

Miss Rhoda Lamb and Miss Mary Elizabeth Lamb to Mrs Doris Newton

Will of Mary Elizabeth Lamb dated 17 October 1980

Mary died 8 October 1989
